Houston Community Services (HCS) is a private non-profit, tax exempt organization with a primary constituency of Latinos. HCS was founded in 1974 by 12 University of Houston students, who came together to discuss various problems faced by the Latina/o community of Houston, most of whom reside in the East End. Through discussion of first hand experiences, it was decided that the best method to address the problems, was to establish a community center. The center would serve as a clearinghouse to inform and educate the community. Thus HCS was incorporated in 1975, with three primary missions: 1) to establish a social service center; 2) to promote cultural and educational enrichment; and 3) to engage in economic development activities.

The Azteca Scholarship was initiated in 1985 as a project of Houston Community Services. Since its inception the Azteca Scholarship has been awarded to 69 Latina/o youth. With your donation of \$25.00 or more, we hope to assist more Latina/o youth in attending college.

With your donation HCS hopes to continue awarding scholarships to first-generation college, C-average (or better) students. This is to include one scholarship for a female and one scholarship for a male. With your support we also hope to expand this scholarship into a full four-year scholarship. - 6) Applications are subject to review by the Board of Directors.
